A funeral service held in our onsite service chapel (Max attendance 30) followed by Direct Cremation.

Direct Cremation is cremation with no attendance at the crematorium.

After the cremation, the remains can be scattered in the grounds of the crematorium, or returned for safe keeping, burial or scattering.

What's included?

Our Services:

- Bringing the deceased person into our care at <u>ANY TIME 24 A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK</u> *Within 30 miles
- The completion and administration of all necessary paperwork.
- Provision of a simple coffin. (With the option to upgrade)
- Care of the deceased within modern and tasteful facilities.
- Unlike most funeral directors we do offer visitation to our chapel of rest with direct cremation.
- Provision of a Hearse to travel direct to Ipswich crematorium.
- Provision of necessary staff for reception at crematorium.

Disbursements included and paid on your behalf are as follows:

- Ipswich Borough Council Crematorium fee for a no service cremation
- Statutory Cremation Form 4 completed by a doctor to give permission for a cremation to go ahead.
- Civil Celebrant or Religious Minister's fee.

Direct Cremation - F.A.Q.s

1. Can I pay my last respects in person?

Yes.

2. Can I attend the crematorium?

No. There will be no service of any kind or attendance allowed by the crematorium.

3. My relative has passed away at home/in a nursing home, can you help?

Yes.

4. Can I collect the ashes?

Yes. We will collect the remains from the crematorium and advise you when you can collect them from us.

5. What else can I do with the ashes?

They can be scattered or buried at a location of your choice, stored in an urn or keepsake from our extensive range or even transformed into a piece of memorial jewellery.

6. Is this a communal cremation?

Absolutely not. In the UK each person is cremated individually.

7. Do you re-use the coffin?

Absolutely not. UK crematoriums only accept people for cremation if they are in a suitable coffin & it cannot be opened once it has been received by the crematorium staff.

8. What kind of coffin do you provide?

We include a simple coffin made from MDF covered with a wood grain effect printed wrapper.
