Our charges for a Simple Chapel Service are £2,595.00.

A service held in our elegantly appointed Chapel. This can be followed by direct cremation, direct burial, or repatriation.

What's included?

- Bringing the deceased person into our care at ANY TIME 24hrs A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK within 30 miles*
- The completion and administration of all necessary paperwork.
- Provision of a basic wood effect coffin, with the option to upgrade to any coffin in our range.
- Care of the deceased within our modern and tasteful facilities.
- Visitation in our Chapel of Rest.
- Use of our Chapel and audio-visual facilities for a funeral service. (Max attendance 35 people).
- Provision of a Hearse to go direct to the place of committal (or repatriation handler) after the service.
- Provision of all necessary staff at the place of committal.

For a Chapel Service with Local Direct Cremation, typical disbursements paid to third parties and which are included are,

- Celebrant or Minister's fee.
- Medical Certificate for Cremation Statutory form completed by the deceased's doctor.
- Ipswich Borough Council Crematorium fee for a no service cremation.

Direct Cremation is cremation with no attendance at the crematorium.

After the cremation, the remains can be scattered in the grounds of the crematorium, or returned for safe keeping, burial or scattering.

The cost for a Chapel Service with the third party fees for Local Direct Cremation is £3,277.00

No. There will be no attendance allowed at the crematorium.

4. Can I collect the ashes?

Yes. They can be collected from us within 3 working days of the cremation.

5. What else can I do with the ashes?

They can be scattered or buried at a location of your choice, stored in an urn or keepsake from our extensive range or even transformed into a piece of memorial jewellery.

6. Is this a communal cremation?

Absolutely not. In the UK each person is cremated individually.

7. Do you re-use the coffin?

Absolutely not. UK crematoriums only accept people for cremation if they are in a suitable coffin & it cannot be opened once it has been received by the crematorium staff.

8. What kind of coffin do you provide?

We include a simple coffin made from MDF covered with a wood grain effect printed wrap
